
Dear Ms Koj,

Thank you for your e-mail of 4 September 2014, in which you draw my attention to the case of Ukrainian air force navigator Ms Nadezhda Savchenko who was captured by separatist militias on 17 June 2014 in Ukraine, and who is now detained in Russia.

The European Parliament is deeply concerned about this case. In its recent resolutions on the situation in Ukraine, on 17 July and 18 September 2014, the Parliament deplored the illegal detention of Ms Savchenko in Russia and demanded her immediate release.

The release of hostages and prisoners is one element in the package of measures to be taken in order to achieve a peaceful settlement of the conflict in eastern Ukraine. The European Parliament will continue to address this matter and will certainly bring up the specific case of Ms Savchenko, in its parliamentary activities and the inter-parliamentary dialogue with its Ukrainian and Russian counterparts.
